Tournament Rules and Regulations

Each team shall consist of 3 or 4 players. All members of the team shall hit one tee shot on every hole. The team then selects one tee shot and all players continue to play from that point. This procedure is repeated until the ball is holed out.

Men play from the WHITE tees and women from the RED tees.

Number of Tee Shots Required:

In a team of four players, each player's tee shot must be used at least three (3) times during the 18 holes competition. In a team of three (3) players, each player's tee shot must be used at least four (4) times during the 18 holes of competition.

Where to Play From:

Each team member must play his/her shot from within one club length of the selected shot (6 inches when on the putting green). However, the ball may not be placed closer to the hole. In addition, if the selected tee shot was in the fairway, each member must place his/her ball in the fairway to play the next shot. Likewise, if the selected tee shot was in the rough, bunker, water hazard, fringe, etc., each member of the team must place the ball in and play from, respectively, the rough, bunker, water hazard, fringe, etc. In every instance each team member may place the ball. Team members may rake bunkers between shots. All players may lift and clean the ball.

Golf Balls Lost or Out of Bounds:

We want you to have a great day, and enjoy some fair and healthy competition. In the interest of maintaining a good pace of play, we ask that your team not spend more than 3-4 minutes looking for lost golf balls. If the shot chosen by your team is hit out of bounds, irretrievably hit into a hazard, or otherwise lost, assess your score a one (1) stroke penalty, and play the next shot no more than 2-club lengths from the point of entry, (no closer to the hole).

Standard Rules:

Otherwise the standard rules of golf will apply, as defined by the RCGA. All rules interpretations will be handled and resolved by the Tournament Organizing Committee.

Scoring:

One person on the team will be required to keep score and one score card from each team may be submitted at the end of the 18 holes to the Pro Shop or Golf Course Personnel.




